Academics	iReady and Case21 BOY assessment data has been certified. MCSA Longitudinal Data Fall data for iReady and Case21 indicate that students are performing in line with our most historical data year over year and across cohorts. iReady is our best indicator for Fall benchmarks because it indicates the readiness of learners to attain grade level standards. MCSA instructional staff and leadership team have analyzed our data from iReady and Case21 and designed a plan for instruction at all Tiers. Tier 1: Teachers meet with coaches/principals weekly to plan classroom instruction that addresses any deficits in knowledge while preemptively planning for instruction of new standards. Tier 2: Classroom intervention is groups are created based on summative assessments, exit tickets and real time teaching. Tier 3: Intervention teams pull out small groups during the schoolwide intervention blocks. After School Tutoring: MCSA is offering targeted after school tutoring in all grades.
